

## COMMUNITY ADVISORY TEAM MEETING SUMMARY

February 18, 2019

The Preble Shawnee Local School District Community Advisory Team (CAT) met for the fourth time on Monday, February 18, 2019.

### Meeting Summary

The meeting began with Superintendent Matt Bishop welcoming the team members. He introduced Jeff Parker and Todd Thackery from SHP Leading Design to lead the evenings activities.

We examined the 20+ options. Each option was broken down into the following columns:

1. Student capacity
2. Square footage
3. LFI (Locally Funded Initiatives) required by the state on the project based on the option being over the base cost of what the state will fund
4. Total cost of the project
5. The local cost which is co-funded at 34% local share along with any mandated or optional LFI's
6. A column that detailed the optional LFI's
7. Debt limit (which limits the amount by law of how much we can borrow for a bond)
8. Millage of a traditional levy
9. PI Levy (a required .5 if we take state money...used for maintenance of buildings)
10. Annual cost of a \$100K home (just used as a traditional example in levies)

After each option was examined and all questions were answered, each member of the CAT was given five green dot stickers and five red. They placed their dots on options they liked and did not like. A summary of the results will be provided in a separate document. We still need an additional meeting to consolidate options that are similar and develop distinct and opposing options for the community to consider at our next Community Forum. We will announce a Community Forum date if significant progress is made at the next CAT meeting.
