### Meeting Summary

The meeting began with Superintendent Matt Bishop welcoming the team members. The group represented the largest attendance since our first meeting. He introduced Jeff Parker and Todd Thackery from SHP Leading Design to lead the evenings activities.

The last time we met, several options were deemed unacceptable to the group. They were eliminated from moving forward. They were Options 2, 3, 3a, 4, 5, and 10. The remaining options were grouped by similarities (i.e. all options with three new/renovated schools, all two new building options, all one renovate/one new options, all renovate two schools options, and finally all K-12 one campus options). These were placed in "heats" and each person was given one green sticker.

Prior to voting, each option in the heat was discussed and all questions were answered so everyone had an understanding of what was proposed. The group voted on one heat at a time with only one green sticker (i.e. what is your preference for the three new/renovated schools options). Members could "burn" their vote each heat by placing it on an option that says "none of these should be considered." At the end of each vote, the group discussed the results.

This was a very productive meeting. There are clear options to present to the community to solicit feedback and answer questions. Hopefully, after the next community forum, we will have clear questions to examine for a possible survey of the voters.
