## Title I Parent Involvement Policy

## Goals:

- 1. Parents will be informed about the Title I program via parental meetings, open houses, and newsletters.
- 2. Parents will be given suggestions for working with their children at home.
- 3. Teachers will be inserviced on Title I parent communication.

## Mechanisms:

- 1. Parents will receive timely information about the Title I program at a parents' meeting held near the start of the school year.
- 2. A progress reports and conferences will be held annually.
- 3. Surveys will be used to gain timely information to review the parent involvement program.
- 4. Parents will receive individual assessment results as appropriate during conferences.
- 5. A copy of the curriculum will be made available to those parents who desire to see it.
- 6. An annual meeting will be held at which parents will be informed of the program's goals.
- 7. Each parent will receive notification of their child's involvement in the Title I program.
