GIFTED IDENTIFICATION

The Ohio Legislature's Amended Substitute House Bill 282 states that all schools must identify any gifted student in their district. This law pertains only to the identification of gifted students. It does not mandate academic programs for gifted students. Preble Shawnee is not offering gifted classes currently.
