Title I Parent Involvement Policy

Goals:

1. Parents will be informed about the Title I program via parental meetings, open houses, and newsletters.
2. Parents will be given suggestions for working with their children at home.
3. Teachers will be inserviced on Title I parent communication.
4. Parents will be involved in the design, operation, and evaluation of the program through annual surveys, parent meetings, home/school communications, progress reports as well as informal conversations.
5. Parent lacking literacy skills or whose native language is not English will have Title I information relayed in an appropriate manner.
6. Any comments or concerns made by parents will receive a timely response.
7. Parents will receive timely information regarding:
 - a. Individual student assessment results
 - b. Description of the curriculum
 - c. Assessment and parent involvement opportunities.

Mechanisms:

1. Parents will receive timely information about the Title I program at a parents' meeting held near the start of the school year.
2. A progress reports and conferences will be held annually.
3. Surveys will be used to gain timely information to review the parent involvement program.
4. Parents will receive individual assessment results as appropriate during conferences.
5. A copy of the curriculum will be made available to those parents who desire to see it.
6. An annual meeting will be held at which parents will be informed of the program's goals.
7. Each parent will receive notification of their child's involvement in the Title I program.
